ORDER

- 1) As per the paper read (1) above, Guidelines were issued with respect to the carrying over the Marks and issue of Mark list/ Grade card of the Lateral Entry students of Manipur, who were admitted to various programmes of Kannur University w.e.f. academic year 2023-24 in view of the decision of the XXVIII Academic Council held on 25.06.2024.
- 2) Subsequently, the Examination Branch, vide papers read (2) & (3), raised certain doubts with respect to these Guidelines and subsequently a Meeting of the Deans Committee, constituted for this purpose, was convened with officials of the Examinations Branch.
- 3) The Meeting of the Deans Committee, as per the paper read (4), scrutinized the Mark lists of a UG and PG candidate from Manipur University, who were admitted by Lateral Entry in an Affiliated Colleges & at the University Department respectively and after deliberations made following Recommendations.

- As Kannur University is following the Grading System for UG & PG, the Committee resolved to convert the Marks scored by the candidates out of 100 into 10 point scale and further worked out the SGPA scored by these candidates from Manipur University and also prepared the formula for calculating CGPA/OGPA as follows.

Therefore Grade Point (GP) = M/10 (M= Marks scored).

Credit Point (CP) = Grade Point (GP) x Credit (C)

As no specific Credit is assigned, a uniform Credit (C) is assigned to all subjects.

Therefore, SGPA = Sum of the Credit points of all Courses in a Semester/Total Credits in that Semester

Therefore SGPA shall be calculated as

$$\text{SGPA} = \frac{\text{GP } 1 \times \text{C} + \text{GP } 2 \times \text{C} + \text{GP } 3 \times \text{C} + \text{GP } 4 \times \text{C}}{\text{C} + \text{C} + \text{C} + \text{C}}$$

$$= \frac{\text{C} (\text{GP } 1 + \text{GP } 2 + \text{GP } 3 + \text{GP } 4)}{4 \text{ C}}$$

$$= \frac{\text{GP } 1 + \text{GP } 2 + \text{GP } 3 + \text{GP } 4}{4}$$

$$\text{CGPA/OGPA} = \frac{S1 \times \text{TCS1} + S2 \times \text{TCS2} + S3 \times \text{TCS3} + S4 \times \text{TCS4}}{\text{Total credit of the Programme}}$$

Total credit of the Programme

Where, S1,S2,S3,S4 are SGPA of Semester 1, Semester 2, Semester 3, Semester 4 respectively.

Where TCS1= Total Credit of Semester 1, TCS2= Total Credit of Semester 2, TCS3= Total Credit of Semester 3 likewise.

- The meeting of the Deans Committee recommended to make applicable the formula for similar cases.
- The meeting observed that the candidate Mr.Winson Haokip joined for B.A.Geography Degree in Manipur University, whereas he was admitted to the B.Sc Geography Programme of Kannur University and recommended to award B.Sc Geography Degree to the candidate as Kannur University is offering this programme under the Faculty of Science.

4)Considering these Recommendations, Vice Chancellor has ordered to place the Minutes of the Meeting, before the Academic Council.

5) The XXIXth Meeting of the Academic Council held on 21/12/2024 vide paper read (5) considered the aforementioned Recommendations of the Committee and approved the same.

6) The Minutes of the Academic Council was approved by the Vice Chancellor and published.

7) Therefore, the Recommendations of the Meeting of the Deans Committee, regarding the conversion of Marks scored by the Lateral Entry Students from Manipur in previous Semesters into the Grading system of Kannur University as furnished under Para (3) above and issuance of Grade card / Certificate in this regard is approved and implemented.

8) The Worksheet of conversion of Marks into Grade and format of Consolidated Grade Card of two candidates concerned, who were Laterally admitted to the affiliated Colleges and University Department respectively are appended with this U.O.



(where S1,S2,S3,S4,S5,S6 are SGPA of Semester1, Semester2, Semester3, Semester4, Semester5, Semester6 respectively and TCS1,TCS2,TCS3,TCS4,TCS5,TCS6 are Total credit of Semester1, Semester2, Semester3, Semester4, Semester5, Semester6 respectively of Kannur University)

$$= (7.1 \times 19 + 5.9 \times 24 + 4.7 \times 16 + 5.9 \times 25 + S5 \times 11 + S6 \times 25) /$$

$$(19 + 24 + 16 + 25 + 11 + 25)$$
